Day of Test Entries Introduction to Quarry, Junior Earthdog, Senior Earthdog and Master Earthdog, entries close 30 minutes prior to the start of each test. Move-up Entries Close Saturday at the close of tests on March 13 for Sunday. Please notify the trial secretary if you have a move-up asap.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date for any titling class or in the event that a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Entry fees for bitches in season will not be refunded.

AWARDS

Qualifying rosettes will be provided for qualifying rounds in all titling classes. A pale green ribbon will be awarded to any dog successfully completing the Introduction to Quarry test. In addition, titling rosettes will be awarded for any dog completing a title.

CHECK-IN AND RUNNING ORDER

Self-check-in for all classes will begin at 8:30 AM each day.

- 1 Master Earthdog Brace Drawing will be held at 8:45 a.m., and Master Earthdog Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m.
- 2 Introduction to Quarry Judging will begin at 9:15 a.m.
- 3 Senior Earthdog Judging will begin at the 9:30 am .
- 4 Junior Earthdog Judging will begin at 10:00 a.m. or after SE on Saturday

Exhibitors must check in prior to the start of their class. Dogs will be run in the order received with consideration given to multiple dogs with the same handler, dogs entered in both intro and a regular class, and to trial volunteers and workers.

THE SITE

The earthdog trial will be held on privately owned property. There is a covered, climate controlled training building on site.

Shade: Exhibitors will be able to use the training building for crating.

Water: Water is readily available on the site.

Food: A vendor will not be available at this trial. Occasionally the club will prepare homemade foods and purchased beverages available for donation.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Dogs six months of age or older and registered with the American Kennel Club are eligible to participate in earthdog tests, as are spayed and neutered dogs. The following breeds are classified as eligible to participate in earthdog tests:

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Dogs of eligible breeds recorded with Purebred Alternative Listing Program/Indefinite Listing Privilege or dogs with Conditional registration are eligible to participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible to participate subject to [Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules](#).

Effective January 1, 2010 All dogs must be individually registered with either the AKC or a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration in order to participate in any AKC Conformation, Performance, or Companion event.

Inasmuch as Dachshunds and Terriers are hunting dogs, dogs disfigured as the result of accident or injury but otherwise qualified shall be eligible provided that the disfigurement does not interfere with functional movement. Dogs that are blind and/or deaf shall not be eligible. Blind means without useful vision, and deaf means without useful hearing.

Dogs may enter only one regular class at an Earthdog test, except dogs which have earned a Master Earthdog Title may enter more than one regular class (Regular classes are classes from which the dogs may earn titles, i.e. JE, SE, ME). No further title certificates will be awarded

A dog is not eligible to enter a test if the Judge of that test or any member of that Judge's family owns or co-owns the dog. The word "family" shall include a spouse, a sibling, a parent or a child, whether natural or adopted, of the Judge in question but shall not extend to other blood or legal relations.

Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. Entry fees paid for a bitch that comes into season shall not be refunded.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AKC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. The organizing committee may refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with AKC will not be allowed entry in the trial.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 fee for any check returned.

Exhibitors who do not clean up after their dogs at the site or at their motels may be dismissed from the trial.

If a dog, while under judgment, attacks another dog or person, and if the Judges are unanimously under the opinion that such attack was without reasonable cause, the judges must disqualify the aggressive dog. An attack does not require a visible physical injury for the judges to disqualify the dog.

Furniture City Kennel Club members/workers/officers will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made..

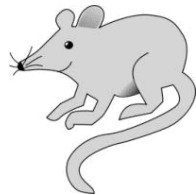
DIRECTIONS TO SITE:

From the East, West, or South: take I-40 to 68 North; Go North to 150 (Old Oak Ridge Road). Follow this to Hwy #220 North. At Stoplight at 220 take a left going North.. Cross over Hwy #158 and take the first hard surface road on the left (Ogburn Mill Road) Go 1/2 mile to signs for parking in pasture. on the right (next to the last trailer). The training building is visible with a blue metal roof.

From the North: Take 220 South to the first hard surface road on the right after the Hwy. 65/220 intersection, (about 7 miles south of Madison, NC). Turn Right on to Ogburn Mill Road and follow directions from above.

From **Motel 6/Red Roof Inn Airport** (allow approximately 30 min.): Turn left on Albert Pick Road, then bear right on NC-68. Bear right onto Oak Ridge Road. Turn left on US-220; go 3.5 miles and turn left onto Ogburn Mill Road. The trial site will be 0.4 miles on your left.

From **Red Roof Coliseum** (allow approximately 30 minutes): Turn right on High Point Road; continue on W Lee Street.. Turn left on S. Aycock Street. Continue on Aycock/Westover Ter./Battleground Avenue/ US-220. Once you are officially on US-220, go 4.7 miles on US-220 and turn Left onto Ogburn Mill Road. The trial site will be 0.4 miles on your left.

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" and the "Earthdog Regulations" have been made available to me(us), and that I am(we are) familiar with their contents, I (we) waive any and all claims and causes of action that I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge judging at this trial, under AKC rules, regulations, and guidelines. I(we) agree that the club holding this earthdog trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the earthdog trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or trial secretary, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the agility trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I(we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I(we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless for any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and for any claim for damage, or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, or injury be caused or be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
